The differences between the two instruments are easier to spot, specially in appearance. While the piano is a large percussion instrument, the guitar is a small flat bodied stringed instrument. The piano has a long keyboard, but the guitar has a long fretted neck. Unlike the piano which stands on its own wooden legs, the guitar usually hangs from a strap and must be held.
